1. The house and all assets should be conveyed to the HEALTHY SPOUSE.
2. The HEALTHY SPOUSE should adjust their estate plan so that if unexpectedly die first:
 - a. The ill spouse will be bypassed pursuant to state law.
 - b. Most of the assets will pass to the children and will not be exposed to the nursing home.
